



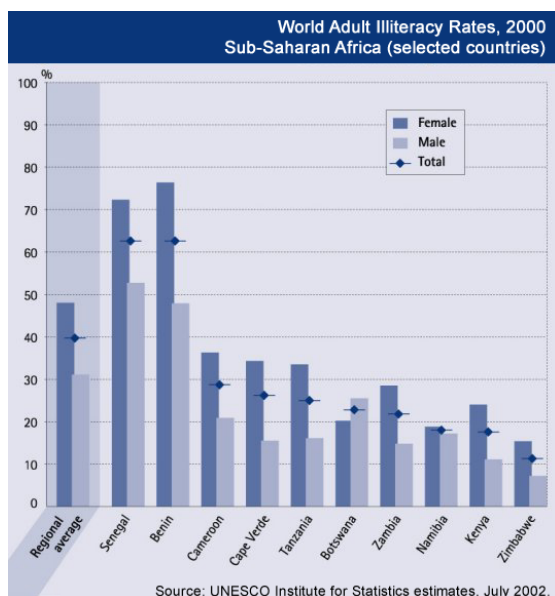
We provide environment for development cooperation projects in the South to rapidly build capacities for e-learning, knowledge management and e-collaboration.

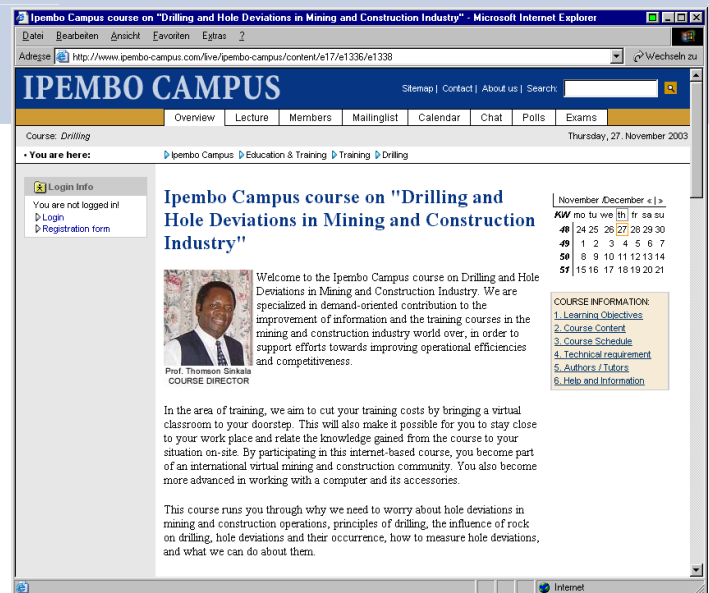
We deliver two types of services:
